This authorization is **CONDITIONAL** and confers **NO** privileges to take, possess, exchange, or transport **other** protected species of plant or wildlife unless the individual has in his possession a valid permit to take other protected species for scientific purposes in the State of Georgia issued by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources-Wildlife Resources Division and/or U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and unless or until that condition is fulfilled, the taking of other protected species is in violation of the regulations as set forth by the State.

PERMITTED ACTIVITY: Tissue Collection (for genetic/molecular analysis)

All personnel working under "Sharon Mozley-Standridge," are authorized to conduct the permitted activity under this permit.

THIS PERMIT APPLIES ONLY UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
